- 1) **Introduction:** (Hebrews 11:23-27)
 - a) We find two champions of faith in this passage:
 - (1) Amram & Jochebed: the parents to Moses.
 - (2) The most powerful and influential people on Earth are parents of faith.
 - b) The family is the primary classroom. (Psalm 68:6)
- 2) Love's Comprehension: (Heb 11:23)
 - a) Amram and Jochebed were people of great faith.
 - i) They were both born of the tribe of Levi.
 - ii) They were students of the Word of God.
 - iii) They knew the prophesy of a deliverer: (Heb 11:22)
 - (1) That 400 years had transpired. (Gen 50:24-25)
 - iv) The faith of Amram and Jochebed was two-fold:
 - (1) They had the written Word.
 - (2) The Spirit of God had spoken to their hearts.
 - b) The joy, privilege, responsibility of a parent. (Ps 112:1-2)
 - c) We must believe God on behalf of our children. (Mk 9:17-24)
 - d) (Prov 22:6) key word "way." heb~bend of a bow
 - i) Every child has a particular "Bent".
 - ii) It is our duty and joy as parents to discover that bent.
 - (1) Try to determine what gifts God has put into that unique, individual person.
- 3) **Love's Courage:** (Hebrews 11:23)
 - a) Amram & Jochebed had every reason to be afraid: (Ex 1:22)
 - b) They realized that their battle was spiritual: (Eph 6:12)
 - c) We need to put the fear out of our lives, as well. (2 Tim 3:1)
 - d) Amram and Jochebed were not afraid of the king's commandment because they knew the King of kings.
- 4) **Love's Call to Action:** (Hebrews 11:23)

- a) They did something.
 - (1) They hid their child from Pharaoh's henchmen.
- b) (James 2:17) "Faith without works is dead." (2 Thes 3:10)
- c) You do your part, and God will do His. (Proverbs 22:6)
 - i) It is our duty to train up our children.
 - (1) Political correctness says that spanking a child is child abuse. (Proverbs 22:15)
 - (2) Political correctness says to give your children birth control. (Hebrews 13:4)
 - (3) Political correctness says that the government should partner with the parents. (Psalm 127:3)
 - (4) Political correctness says that you should let your children choose their own sexual preference. (Lev 18:22)
- d) Faith honors God, and God honors faith. (Exodus 2:3-9)
- 5) **Love's Conclusion & Crowning Achievement** (Heb 11:24-27)
 - a) Faith is the victory that overcomes the world.
 - b) Moses had caught a glimpse of Jesus and endured.
 - c) Moses was faced with tremendous temptation.
 - d) Moses was offered a choice:
 - e) Moses made his decision by Evaluation: (Heb 11:26)
 - f) Moses made his decision by Determination: (Heb 11:25)
 - g) Moses made his decision by Elimination: (Heb 11:24, 27)
