#### **SECOND Scriptural Baptism:**

Ethiopian Eunuch (Acts 8:36-37) Have to be Saved 1st! Christ's Death Burial & Resurrection: (Rom 6:3-5) Christ's Teaching & Scriptural Doctrines: (Acts 19:3-6)

#### S - Separation of the Church

**Separation of Church from State Control:** (Matt 22:15-22)

Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD... (Ps 33:12)

We are to be salt & light in our generation: (Matt 5:13,14) Government has the responsibility to protect innocent citizens and punish evil doers (Romans 13:1, 6).
