7:00 PM PAS 301 Advanced Homiletics I

Continued development of sermonizing techniques and skills, focusing on the principles of expository preaching.

8:00 PM BIB 211 Theology Proper / Bibliology M. Aylestock This course examines the doctrine of Bibliology, the foundation of all theological truth, and the doctrine of God (Theology Proper). Bibliology covers the rational steps of the transmission of truth from the heart of God to the lifestyle of man – Origination, Revelation, Inspiration, Preservation, Illumination, and Application. Theology Proper covers the Existence, Nature, Attributes, Names, Decrees, Works of God as well as the more recent concept of Open Theism.

7:00 PM INT 212 People of the Bible

In many ways, the Bible is a book about people – it mentions over 3,000 people by name, and many more by life position or nationality. This course will examine many of the key figures and people-groups of the Scriptures, providing a contextual basis on which the historical events of the Bible stand.

8:00 PM INT 202 Bible Background

A challenge facing today's Bible students is understanding the background context – the Old and New Testament doctrines and practices, culture, customs, daily activities, archaic terminology, metrics (time, distance, mass and volume), places, events, and key characters that may not be familiar to the modern lay person. This course will examine many Bible background elements critical to understanding passages of scripture. Research, discovery, and practical application activities will help students develop the resources and skills necessary to answer future Bible background questions.

9:00 PM BIB 312 Romans

An in-depth study of the book of Romans, the great treatise on justification, salvation, and sanctification.
